- ▶ Cite simple traits shared by most works.
- ▶ Remember that there is often more than one correct way to document a source.
- ▶ Make your documentation useful to readers.

A FEW PRINCIPLES

Rather than a long list of rules

- ▶ **WHO** is the author of the source? Are they qualified? Biased? Somehow related to the topic?
- ▶ **WHAT** is the source? Does it have a title? How would it be described (document, creative work, artifact)? Is it authoritative? Does it have sources?
- ▶ **HOW** was the source produced? Published? Vetted?
- ▶ **WHERE** did you find the source? Cited in another work? Commercial search engine?
- ▶ **WHEN** was the source published? Might it have been replaced?

THINK

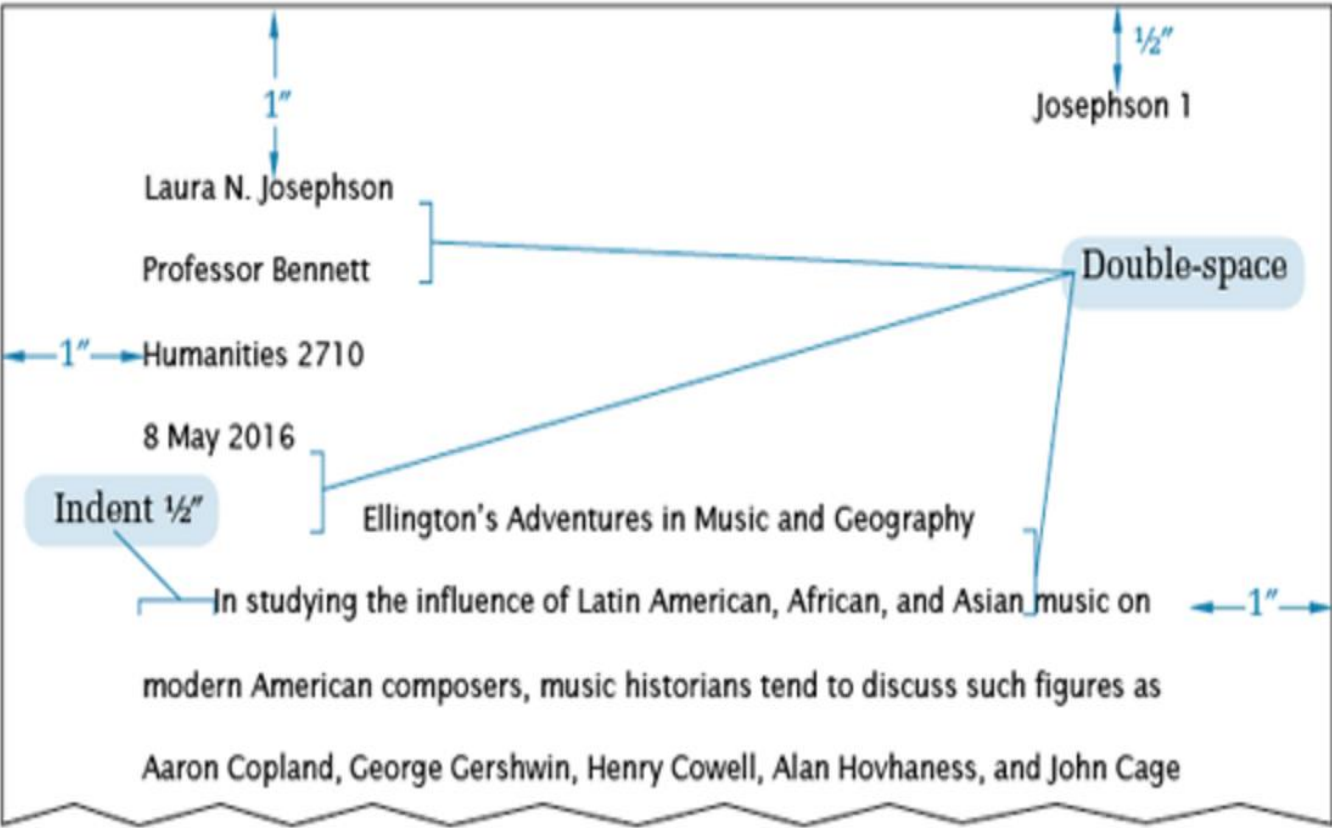
- ▶ Collect the “who”, “what”, “how”, “where”, “when” information as you discover useful works.
- ▶ Examine the work itself for the above information. Do not rely on listings found elsewhere.
- ▶ Generally, look in places where the publisher, author, or creator gives credit for the production.

SELECT

- ▶ A citation should provide a road map leading to the original source while interrupting the reader's engagement with the text as little as possible.
- ▶ MLA style has two parts:
 - ▶ A detailed entry in a list of Works Cited
 - ▶ A citation in the text: a minimal reference that directs the reader to the Works Cited entry

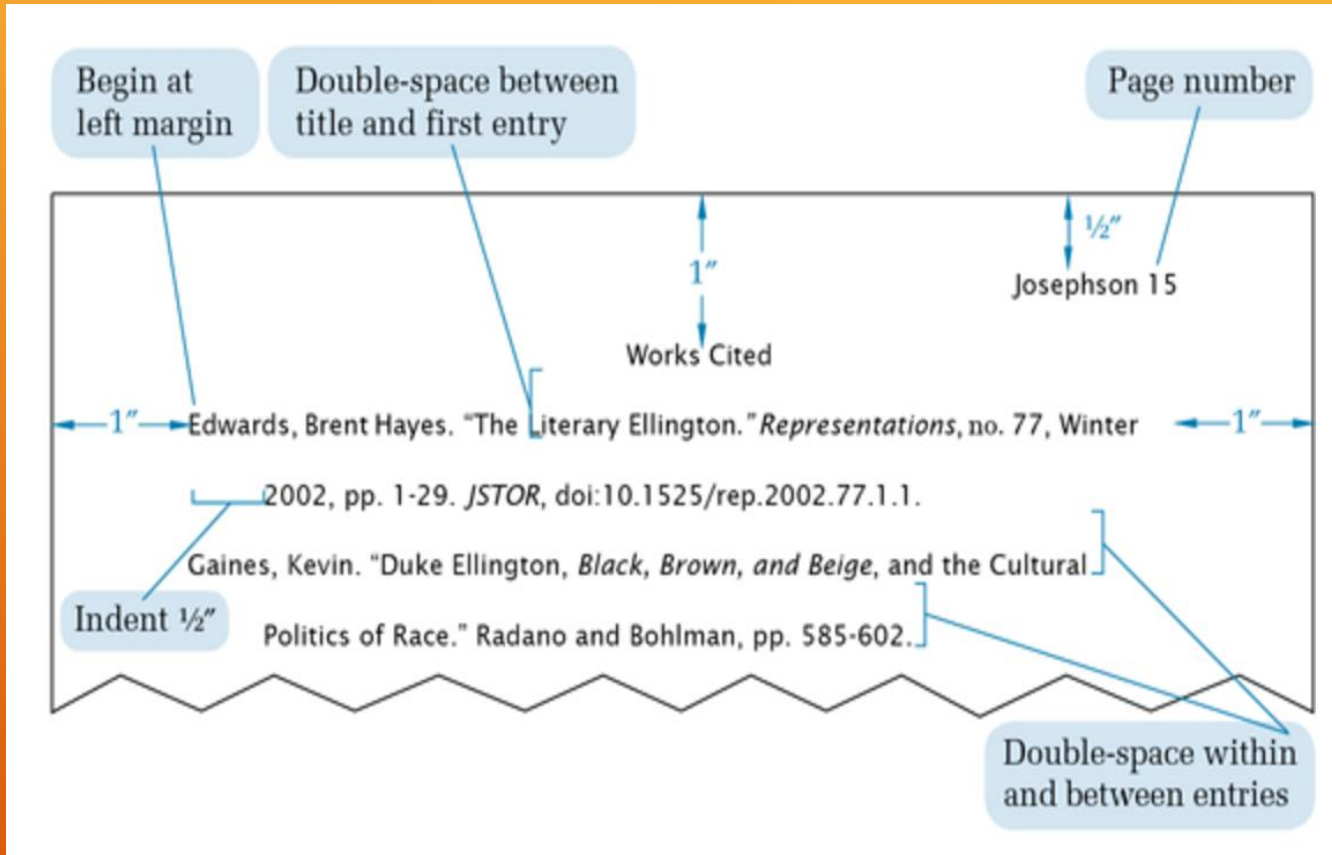
RESEARCH PAPER FORMAT



A research paper does not need a title page. Begin one inch from the top of the first page, flush with the left margin, type your name, your instructor's name, the course number, and the date on separate lines, double-spacing the lines. On a new, double-spaced line, center the title. Number all pages consecutively throughout the research paper in the upper right-hand corner, half an inch from the top, flush with the right margin. Type your last name, followed by a space, before the page number.

WORKS CITED PAGE

The list of works cited appears at the end of the paper, after any endnotes. Begin the list on a new page. The list contains the same running head as the main text. The page numbering in the running head continues uninterrupted throughout. Center the title, *Works Cited*, an inch from the top of the page. Center the title, *Works Cited*, an inch from the top of the page.

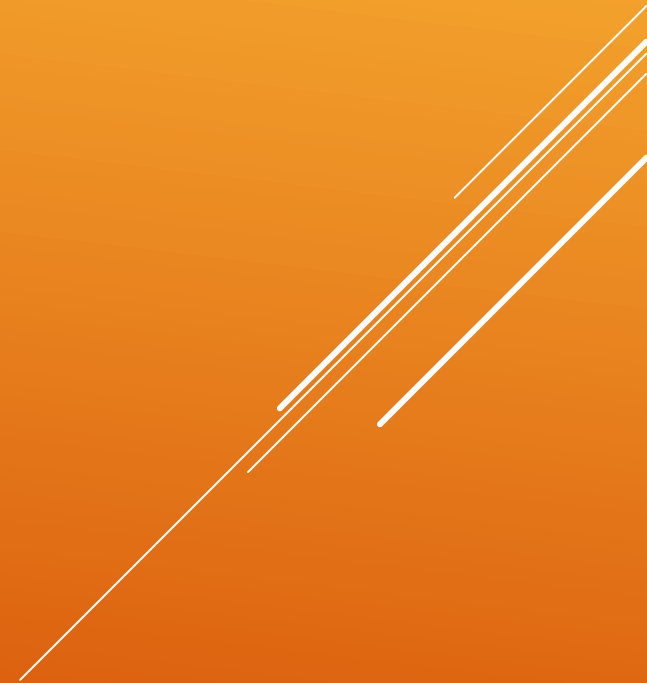
- ▶ A citation in the text, a minimal reference that directs the reader to the entry.

For the *Migration* series, Lawrence first did library research so he could understand his subject. He wrote the captions (which make up part of the story), and then he outlined each panel with pencil (Steele 248). His compositions do not often use traditional three-dimensional perspective. The style of the series exhibits what Ellen Harkins Wheat calls "cubist angularity" (62). What is most interesting is the way he painted the series (Steele 250). He started with black
