


Font • Title: 72 point • Headings/section titles: 40 point • Body text: 24 point • Captions: 18 point • Use a maximum of 3 fonts and keep sizes consistent and readable • Suggested fonts: Sans serif: Lucida Sans, Lucida Grande, Serif: Palatino, Book Antiqua **Colors** • You may use the following colors: o Red: o Black: #000000 White: #FFFFF • Gray scale is also acceptable Specs Landscape • Size: 48" x 36" • If using templates, open in Powerpoint • Must include Honors logo **DEADLINE FOR POSTER SUBMISSION: 11/07** Link to Steelman poster printing



Poster Content Guidelines

Sections (these vary by thesis type)


- Introduction (what you did)
- Literature Review
- Methods (how you did it)
- Results
- Conclusion (what you learned)
- Sources (for images and direct quotes in the poster)

Content

- Each box can be in bullet points or a paragraph.
- Make sure you have charts, graphs and pictures in a good balance relative to text.
- Anyone reading your poster alone should be able to grasp the main ideas in your thesis, so make sure to be concise.

Slides Format

Content

- Use concise bullet points and refrain from using paragraphs. The audience should be looking at you, not reading the slides.
- Images are highly encouraged.
- Do not use flamboyant colors.
- Professionalism in design is expected.
- Slides should be coherent, well-designed, free from errors, and relevant.
- · Seek balance between highly engaging and academic research.
